

Off your Trolley?

No? If you normally have to leave your Shrimper on its trolley and would like to get to the bottom of things, try inverting the wood track, screw it down, and position three or four, one inch blocks on top, spaced to avoid the centreplate housing. You will then be able to scrape off all the barnacles and antifoul all those bits you couldn't get to. You will need to chock the hull to stop it rocking, and to guide the boat on to the trolley, temporarily screw a short plank, slanted, 6" deep either side of the forward end of the trolley.
