

## Solent to Poole Mini-Cruise – May 2020

### Ahoy Solent Shrimpers!

Just to say we'd like to invite you to join a special mini-cruise from the Solent to Poole Harbour in May.

It is probably in your diary already and there are still some details to finalise, but this note is to seek your appetite as being a 'Yes', 'Maybe' or a 'No'! We would like to have a good idea by March 28<sup>th</sup> please so the remaining berthing and catering arrangements can be made

We plan to pass Hurst between 09.00 and 10.00 on Monday 18 May and return Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> pm or early morning Friday 22<sup>nd</sup>

So, why is this mini cruise so special?

Firstly, it is open to all Shrimpers on a first come basis whether you are normally based in Chichester, East Solent, Central Solent, West Solent or even in Poole. In fact, it is entirely open with the hope that we will meet some new Shrimper friends.

Secondly, it piggy-backs on to a mini-Solent cruise being led by Poole Shrimpers so the hope is we will be able to integrate some sailing and social activities in the Solent and in Poole, giving you the best chance of joining up

Thirdly, by combining the cruise with activities already in place in Poole we anticipate all interests of cruising, racing, shopping, partying, etc., can be met!

We intend to have a 'Mother Ship' and 'Plan B' for each day as we all know it is possible the departures may be delayed due to adverse weather. The 'Plan B' will be flexible enough to accommodate super sailing and pleasant social events in either sailing region, the Solent or Poole Harbour. The possibility of using cars or trains has also been considered and these finer details will be worked on during April.

Depart Poole Fri 15<sup>th</sup> May for Solent, led by *Camaron* (940), skippered by Karen Macey;

Friday 15<sup>th</sup> Meet Bell buoy 10am (tbc) and sail east. Evening in Yarmouth

Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> Day sail with some Solent Shrimpers. Evening RAF Club, Hamble

Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> Day sail with some Solent Shrimpers. Evening in Lymington

Monday 18<sup>th</sup> Pass Hurst between 9 and 10 am. with 'Solent Shrimpers' heading west

**Chichester and Solent Shrimpers:**

Depart West Solent Monday 18<sup>th</sup> May for Poole Harbour - led by *Bluejay* (1152), skippered by Mark Jenkins

Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> West Solent, probable night in Lymington. Decision at noon re tomorrow

Monday 18<sup>th</sup> Pass Hurst between 9 and 10 am, tbc with the Poole Shrimpers returning home

Afternoon at Parkstone YC. Presentation of Shrimper Harbour Plan (**SHP**) see below

Evening at Parkstone YC, Weekly Sailors Dinner booked at Parkstone YC.

**SHP Options Tues-Thursday:**

Round the Islands, Brownsea, Round, Long, etc

Join Parkstone YC Shrimper race (on your boat or as crew with a Poole boat) at 18.00 on 18<sup>th</sup>

Join Royal Motor Shrimpers at 10.45 on 19<sup>th</sup> for short cruise and lunch

Sail to Old Harry/Swanage

Day/night at Poole Quay for 'famous shoe shopping'

Sail/motor to Rockley, Wareham

Use Training Room facilities at Parkstone YC – subject Tbc

Join Parkstone YC afternoon race on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup>

Join Poole Shrimpers morning cruise on Thursday 21<sup>st</sup>

Anchor in Studland Bay with a beach BBQ

Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> Mid-afternoon return to Solent for some, passing Hurst after 15.30

Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> Early morning return to Solent for some, passing Hurst before 11.00
